

You will need:

- Paper bag
- Construction paper or any colored paper
- Glue
- Scissors

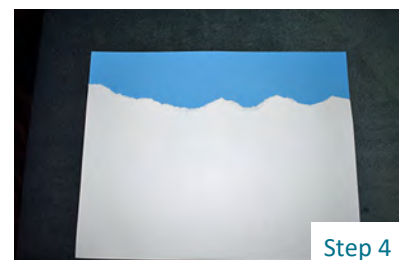
Optional:

- Paint
- Yarn
- Chenille Sticks (pipe cleaners)



Directions:

1. Using the bison template, trace or draw the bison onto a piece of paper bag or construction paper and cut out.
2. Paint the head section a darker brown or just cut it out of a darker brown construction paper.
3. Once the paint has dried, crumple the paper up into a ball then open back up. This gives the bison more texture!
4. To make the background, start with a full sheet of blue paper. Then take a piece of white paper and tear the top 1/4 of the paper off making very uneven tears to form the mountains. Glue onto the blue paper.
5. Next tear a green piece of paper in half and glue onto the white paper. Then tear off about 1/4 of a yellow piece of paper and glue onto the green paper.



6. **Optional:** Paint clouds or grass. To get the grass effect, lightly paint orange paint over the yellow paper and use the non-brush end of a paintbrush to scratch out the grass.



7. Glue your bison onto your grassland!



8. Cut out a horn from white paper or use a piece of white chenille stick and glue onto the head. Use either a black chenille stick or a piece of yarn to make the tail and glue onto the back of the bison.
