

## **Standing Cougar**

## You will need:

- Tan or yellow, black and white construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black marker



## **Directions:**

- 1. Fold your full sheet of tan/yellow construction paper in half lengthwise and cut in half along the crease line just made
- 2. With one of the halves, fold it in half to create a line in the middle of the paper
- 3. Take one end of the paper fold it over and line up the edge with crease in the middle of the paper and press down.

  Repeat with the other end
- 4. On one end of the paper, fold over about an inch of paper
- 5. At the other end of the paper cut 2 lines to the crease making about a half inch wide rectangle (this will be the cougar's tail) in the middle of that section
- 6. With the two larger rectangles created, cut the corners and create 2 rounded ends making the feet of the cougar
- 7. Fold the "tail" back and then take the end with the inch fold in it and fold it over creating a triangle and glue the bottom edge to the feet
- 8. With the other half of the tan/yellow paper, trace a large circle (head) about the width of the paper (I used a large glass) and cut out the circle and 2 ears
- 9. On the white paper cut out 2 quarter-sized circles (outer eyes) and with the black paper cut out 2 dime-sized circles (inner eyes) and 1 triangle (nose) then round off the 2 corners of the triangle
- 10. Glue the inner eyes on to the outer eyes and then glue eyes, nose and ears to the head piece
- 11. Draw on a mouth and decorate however you want
- 12. Round off the corners on the top edge of the body triangle
- 13. Glue head on to the body and enjoy!























# **Standing Cougar**


## You will need:

- 2 small paper bags
- Pink, black and white construction paper
- White pipe cleaner
- Glue
- Scissors

Optional: large wiggly eyes

## **Directions:**

- 1. Using one paper bag, cut out the arms and ears (see image for shape ideas)
- 2. With the pink construction paper cut out the foot pads (see image for shape), an inch wide heart for the nose and quarter -sized circles for the inner ears



- 4. Cut out 2 dime-sized circles out of the black construction paper for the inner eyes (if you have large wiggly eyes, you can skip this step and cutting out white circles)
- 5. Glue the white heart, pink heart and eyes to the 2nd paper bag- make sure to glue to the side that has the bottom flap visible
- 6. Glue inner ears to the outer ears and attach to the back of the bag
- 7. Cut pipe cleaner in to 4 pieces and glue on to white heart to make whiskers
- 8. Draw on mouth and any other decorations you wish
- 9. Glue the pink foot pads to the arms and attach arms to the bag by gluing it to the underside of the side fold
- 10. Place hand in bag and be a cougar!
