

You will need:

- Paper
- Paints

- Pencil

Directions:

1. If you have help, paint both of your hands and make your handprints with both thumbs facing up and as close together as possible. If you don't have help, paint one hand at a time and make your handprints as close together as you can. If you have large hands like me, you may have to overlap your prints to fit on the page!
2. Draw a hawk shape around your handprints.
3. Paint the outline.
4. Paint your hawk filling in as much or as little as you want!
