

**You will need:**

- Rocks
- Paint and paint brushes
- Glue
- Construction paper or cardstock
- Scissors

**Optional:**

- Beads or clay



**Directions:**

1. Find a large round smooth rock and 2 smaller flattish rocks.



2. Paint your rocks whatever color you want your frog to be.



3. Glue the smaller rocks under the large rock to make the frog's legs.



4. Glue on eyes. You can either use small round rocks, beads, or make your own out of clay. Paint if needed.



5. Decorate your “frocks” however you want!



6. Cut a lily pad shape out of construction paper or cardstock and glue your “frock” to it’s pad!
