

**Objective:** Students will be able to identify what type of teeth their favorite animal should have based on what they eat.

**You will need:**

- 2 pieces of white paper (can use construction paper as well )
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloring Utensils (if you don't use construction paper)

**Background:**

Choose your favorite animal! What do they eat? Are they an omnivore, carnivore, or herbivore?

- Carnivores eat meat and have mostly sharp teeth
- Herbivores eat plants and have mostly flat teeth
- Omnivores eat plants and meat and usually have both flat and sharp teeth

**Directions:**

Choose an animal to make and put the appropriate type of teeth in it's mouth! You can use construction paper, or you can use white paper and color your animal!

1. Make the head of your animal with your first piece of paper.
2. Fold a second piece of paper in half and cut the shape of your mouth out. Be sure not to cut on the fold.
3. Glue the bottom flap of your mouth to the head, but leave the top flap free.
4. Add eyes, ears, nose, and any other features you'd like to your animal.
5. Open it's mouth and draw or cut out the appropriate teeth for your animal.

**Optional:** Take it further by writing any interesting information about the animal on the back or in its mouth like diet or where they live.
