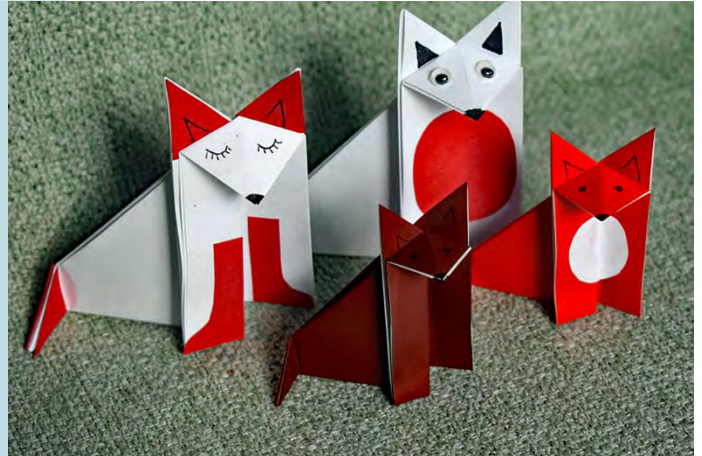


You will need:

- Square piece of paper – any color or size (the thinner the paper the better)
- Markers

Optional:

- Wiggly eyes
- Glue
- Scissors

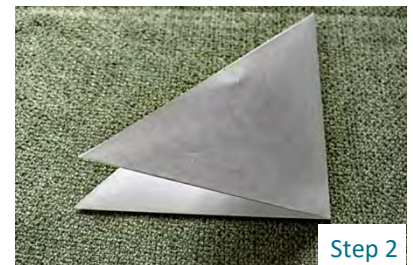


Directions:

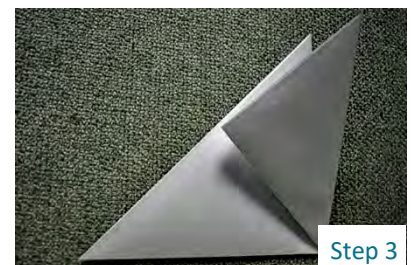
1. If needed, cut your paper to make it a square. Turn the paper so one corner is pointing towards you and bring the corner closest to you up to the corner furthest from you and crease to make a triangle.



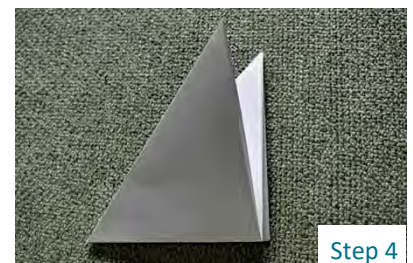
2. Keep the fold of the triangle towards you and take the right side corner and fold over to meet the left side corner.



3. Take the uppermost corner of the two left corners and fold it up to meet the corner furthest away from you.



4. Flip the paper over and fold the right corner up to the top corner like in step 3. One side of your new triangle should look like a “W”.



5. Fold over the side with the “W” about ½-1”.



6. Take the top piece of the fold over you just made and open it up.



7. Fold down the center point at the top to make the face of the wolf.



8. Fold over the left corner about ½-1” to make the tail of the wolf.



9. Decorate your wolf as little or as much as you want and repeat as many times as you would like to make your own wolf pack!
