

Brown Bear Claws

You will need:

 Any type of full size paper thinner is better. You need one sheet per claw.

Optional:

 Markers, color pencils, crayons, paint—to decorate them if you choose.



Directions:

- 1. Lay your paper on a flat surface. Take the top right corner and fold it down so the top edge matches the left edge.
- 2. Take the left top corner and fold it down to the right side fold so you now have a triangle above a rectangle.
- 3. Fold the left bottom corner so that the edges now line up with the base of the triangle. Fold the right bottom corner the same way.
- 4. Now make a fold at the base of the triangle to bring the bottom edge of the paper up.
- 5. Fold the right side over so that the top is still pointed and the edge now lines up with the center of the folded sheet.
- 6. Fold the left side the same way the right side was done in step five.
- 7. Fold the right side over one last time.
- 8. Now tuck in the flap that was just folded over so the claw stays held together.
- 9. Optional: Decorate your bear claws with markers, color pencils, crayons or paint.
- 10. Put your claws on and explore the world like a bear!
