Background:

What is habitat enrichment? It is the alteration of the physical elements in and around a space in which an animal lives. Habitat enrichment has many different aspects and is easy to try at home.

Enrichment is not just toys or treats, a big part of enrichment involves a changing of the animal's living space.



Introduction:
