


Reusable Animal Myths and Misunderstandings Match Game

You will need:

- 1 long sheet of construction paper
- 4 different colored sheets of construction paper
- 30 sets of Velcro buttons
- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers
- Ruler



Directions:

1. Take the long sheet of construction paper and fold it in half so the short edges meet.



2. On one sheet of your construction paper write your titles



3. Cut out each title and glue at the top from left to right on the inside of the folded paper, then add the main title on the front cover.






4. Gather the remaining 3 sheets of paper. On the first page write each animal myth or misunderstanding. On second page write 'true,' 'busted,' or 'both' in order to match your misunderstandings. On third page write your facts for the 'why or why not?' column. Use the ruler to help outline each statement.



5. Cut out each statement. Before you place your Velcro buttons, be sure that each of your statements fit in the appropriate column. If they do not fit, then trimming around the edges may be necessary.



6. Place the Velcro loop (soft side) buttons under each title column, then place a Velcro hook (rough side) button on the back of each statement.



- 7. Match them up! The Velcro allows this game to be reusable so you can share it with friends and family and help them clear up animal myths and misunderstandings too.
