

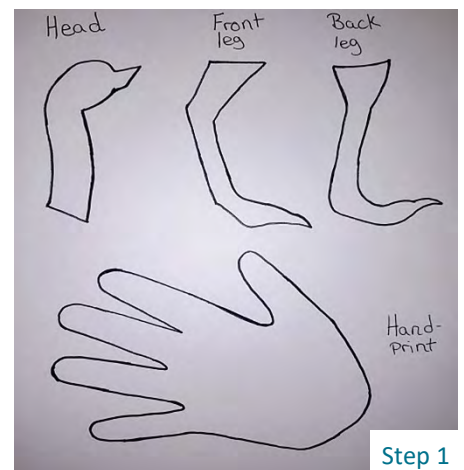
**You will need:**

- 1 piece of white construction paper
- 1 piece of black construction paper
- Pencil
- Pink colored pencil
- Orange colored pencil
- Black marker
- Scissors
- Glue



**Directions:**

1. On the top of the white sheet of paper draw the head, front leg, back leg, followed by tracing your handprint at the bottom of the paper. You can also print out the template pictured in step 1.

2. After you have completed step 1, use your scissors to cut out the head, legs, and handprint.



Step 2

3. Using the black sheet of paper trace and cut out your handprint.



Step 3

4. Place the black handprint over the white so that all of the finger 'feathers' are visible. Once you have this in place, glue the prints together.



5. Lightly color the head and legs using your pink colored pencil. Use the orange colored pencil to color the beak, and use the black marker for the line in the middle of the beak, to draw in the eye, and to color in the toes.



6. Glue the legs to the back of the white handprint.



7. Glue the bottom of the neck to the back of the white handprint, and now you have your very own hands-on ostrich!
