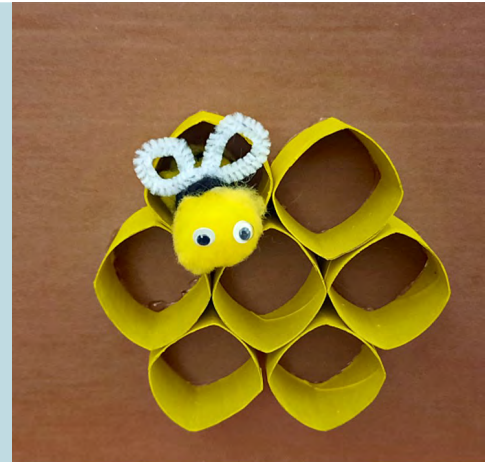


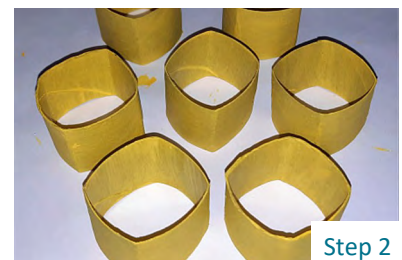
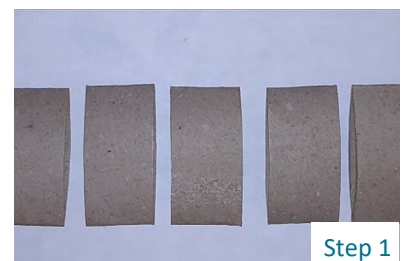
You will need:

- Brown construction paper
- Yellow paint
- Empty paper towel roll
- 1 black pipe cleaner
- 1 white pipe cleaner
- 2 yellow pom poms
- 2 small googly eyes
- Glue
- Scissors

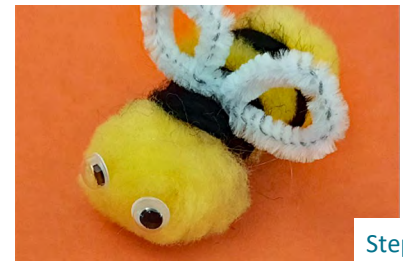


Directions:

1. Cut your paper towel roll into 7 sections.
2. Paint the sections yellow and set aside to dry. These will be the cells of your beehive.
3. While the paint is drying, begin to build the bee by gluing the 2 yellow pom poms together.
4. Take the white pipe cleaner and wrap around the middle of your bee and fold inward to create the wings.
5. Cut your black pipe cleaner in half and wrap one around the front of your bee followed by wrapping the other half around the end of your bee.



6. Now glue the 2 small googly eyes onto the very front of your bee and set aside.

7. Lay your piece of construction paper on a flat surface and arrange your cells in hive formation and glue in place.

8. Let your bee enjoy!
