

Nature Weaving Porcupine

You will need:

- A piece of cardboard
- Marker
- Scissors
- Sticks
- Rubber bands
- 1 stick-on googly eye



Directions:

1. Start by drawing the shape of your porcupine's body and head.



2. Using the scissors, cut out your porcupine. Then draw on the mouth, color in the nose, and stick-on the googly eye to create the face.



 Make small cuts on the top, bottom, and sides of the porcupine, followed by looping rubber bands between the cuts. Arrange these any way you want, but be sure they overlap in order to make weaving the sticks successful.



4. Begin weaving your sticks, which will simulate the quills of a porcupine.



5. You can also collect other nature items such as flowers and leaves to decorate your porcupine!
